"Feel Brave" programme: Our school has been accepted into the pilot programme of a new well-being programme designed to help children express how they are feeling, what is bothering them and enable them to build strategies around coping. The programme has been devised and written by a New Zealand author – Avril McDonald. She suffered from anxiety as a child so this is a topic that is very close to her heart. We are very excited to be part of this new up-to-the-minute programme which will benefit our children on both an emotional level as well as a social one. It will cover things like positive relationships, change, loss and grief, anxiety and self-confidence among other things. We believe that this programme will build beautifully on our "How to be a bucket-filler" programme which was implemented in Room 2 last year. I'm sure your children will keep you fully informed as we work through the programme! We will send more information home next week.
