Whānau Picnic and Meet the Newbies: What a GREAT evening we had! It was quite literally THE best one we've ever had! Reminder: Parent Information Evening: Across last year, our staff did a number of professional learning sessions focussing on what we see coming into our classrooms more and more – childhood depression, anxiety, childhood trauma, to name a few. One of the professionals we worked with was Jenny from CAMHS (Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service). She and I got talking about the potential for planning an information evening early this year for a small number of our school's parents who may have children who face these types of difficulties. Suffering from this type of thing as an adult can be hard; as a child it can be crippling! We have scheduled this parents session for Tuesday 12 March, from 7pm. We will provide child care for anyone who needs it as we'd love to see both parents attend! If you are interested in attending, please contact me. We still have plenty of spaces available, and there is no cost involved for you, just a lot of validation, strategies and support!

Featherston Cluster Swimming Sports: This is happening next Tuesday 27th February (pp day Thursday 29th) and only involves those tamariki who have qualified. Information notices went home to their parents today, and must be back by Monday morning, please. If the organisers postpone, it will be because of the weather and temperature. I'll let the parents of those involved know if the event is postponed as soon as I know.

No swimming days next week: There is the potential that we may have two days next week where we don't go swimming as a whole school. With the Cluster Swimming Sports taking place on Tuesday, there will be NO SWIMMING for the rest of the school on that day. If the event is postponed to Thursday due to bad weather or low temperatures on Tuesday, we will have no swimming on Thursday either because that is the postponement day for the Swimming Sports. Obviously, if it's not good enough for the Cluster Swimming Sports to go ahead on Tuesday then we wouldn't be going swimming anyway. . .

PARENT INFORMATION

Kia ora koutou

Welcome to Whare Humarie After School Care which will be starting at Te Kura O Paetūmokai Featherston School from Thursday 08 February 2024. We have Ms Sue Campbell joining us as our programme supervisor from day one. It would be great for you to come in and introduce yourselves so she knows who you are as you sign your children out at the end of the day.

At present we are still waiting to be OSCAR affiliated, hopefully that process will not take too long to come through. I will check up tomorrow with how that is coming along. Until then the charges are as follows:

For the first child: \$7 per hour

For every child after that: \$3.50 per hour

Casual students: \$7 per hour (to be paid upfront online)

Parents who have children attending on a regular basis will have an invoice emailed fortnightly.

Your children will be provided with healthy snacks, fun activities and a safe environment to enjoy the time after school. If the weather is too hot we will open the hall so they have a cooler place to play in. The whole of our campus is open including our playgrounds, bike track and PE equipment.

Please ensure that you sign your children out from the programme when you pick them up as this is a Health and Safety requirement. If you are going to be late or have organised for alternative pick up arrangements please let Sue know prior to pick up. She will give you contact details as she meets you.

This is an initiative to help raise funds towards repairing the indoor pool at the Carterton Pools complex.
