

## **Arrival Time at School**

Kia ora ki te whānau o Te Kura o South Featherston! Welcome back to another exciting term! We will be chasing our tails again, busy-ness wise so please make sure you keep up to date by reading this newsletter each week, and any other emails or notices that might come to you, so that you know exactly where your kidlet (and you!) need to be!

**Nau mai haere mai ki to tātou kura/Welcome:** We have had two new learners join us this term. Jordie (little brother to Cobie) starts his school journey with us as a New Entrant, and we welcome back Viaan and his family. Viaan has joined Ronel and her band of merry mischief-makers.

**Welcome to Alison Power:** It is also my great pleasure to welcome Alison into the role of LJR (Little Junior Room) teacher for the remainder of this year. Alison is well known to us all here at our kura (staff, some parents and tamariki alike) because she has worked alongside us for the past 6 years as a RT:LB (Resource teacher of learning and behaviour). Alison had the little office beside Ronel's Middle Room once the RT:LB service moved to be based out of our school. We are hugely lucky to have someone with Alison's knowledge and expertise working with us. Please ensure you make her feel welcome when you use her about the place.

Contacting staff outside of school hours: Just a reminder about the expectation that staff won't be answering emails or phone calls after 6pm on weekdays, or on their much needed weekends. Y5-8 Football Tournament: This is happening next Wednesday 31 July (with the postponement day being Friday 2 August) at the Featherston Football grounds on Underhill Road. This year, we have TWO teams entered; a Year 7/8 (with some Y6s) Competitive team, and a Year 5/6 (with a couple of Y4s) Social team. The Y7/8 team players MUST wear football boots and shin pads. The Y5/6 team can only wear running shoes - shin pads are totally optional there but no football boots allowed for the Year 5/6 team. There will be a bbq selling sausages in bread, and bottled water. If you're at a loose end, I need a few more volunteers to help with that, please.

**Please**, **please**, **PLEASE** name all of your child's gear: We are accumulating a load of lost uniforms bits 'n pieces, and requests from parents to help their children find their gear.
