Kia ora te whanau o South Featherston Kura... and my apologies for the lateness of this week's newsletter. I try to get them out on Wednesdays, but our staff have had a full on week this week with professional learning workshops, and meetings after school. Please continue to read these newsletters so you are fully informed with what's coming up in these last 4 weeks of Term 3.

Kindy visit: Tomorrow, our Junior Room welcomes the 4+ year olds from Meta Riddiford kindy for the next of our regular visits for our local soon to be big-school kids. It's always a delight to have these wee ones in the classroom and playground, and to watch just how caring our 5 and 6 years olds become with them! The Maori concept of tuakana teina relationships, where the older support, guide and teach the younger ones, is alive and well within our tamariki!

The Green Group: One of the groups that has naturally formed from within the overarching fundraising group is the 'The Green Group'. This is a dedicated bunch

of parents (mostly mums!) who definitely have green thumbs and have come together to build up our cache of seedlings and 'plantlets' ready for selling at our Country Fair in November. They also spent most of last Saturday voluntarily doing a big clean out of our PE & Gardening shed and the difference difference is pretty phenomenal! Not only do we know what we have in there in terms of tools but we also have some space do more in there now! I wish I'd had a before and after pic to show you!

Whitakers Chocolates fundraiser: Please continue to send in your empty boxes and \$90 once you've sold all the bars. The sales are going SUPER well, so thanks to all for the great efforts PARTICULARLY our fabulous kidlets who are out there doing the hard



graft! We will be looking at coming out with approximately \$3400 in profit. We'd budgeted to raise \$6000 this year for fundraising so a great start!

Holidays during term time: One of the things we continue to focus on is student attendance, and how poor attendance greatly affects learning achievement. Holidays in term time have become an epidemic this year at our school. We are only 2 ½ terms in, and so far there have been 29 of our 70 learners who've been taken away from school to go on a family holiday. The Ministry guidelines for this are very clear: a family holiday during term time is NOT an acceptable reason and is categorised as an UNJUSTIFIED absence. Under the Education and Training Act 2020, principals can allow a student a JUSTIFIED absence from school for up to 5 days if there is a justified reason for that absence, eg: illness, or a funeral/tangi. If your child is away for one day per fortnight/5 days a term (one week across a 10-week term) by the time they are 16, they will have missed one whole year of learning. There are a lot of our learners who are away way more than this, and if you do the maths, at 2 days per fortnight that's two years of learning that will be missed by the time your child is 16 yrs old. Every day is important when it comes to your child and their achievement. Every day your child is away they miss important instruction, or essential skills, or the beginning of a new piece of learning which their teacher then has to take time away from others to fill in your child with. Every day your child is away means they won't learn or achieve what they could have if they'd been here more.


